Plaistow and Kirdford Annual Easter Egg Roll for Years R to 6

We are excited to announce the return of our whole school Easter Egg Rolling Event! We will be conducting the competition within our bubbles and aim to livestream the grand final. As in previous years, children will bring in a hard-boiled, decorated egg on Monday 29th March to roll from the top of a small ramp with their class.

The rules are simple:



- 1. The hen's egg must be hard-boiled.
- 2. The egg should be decorated by hand using paint or felt tips so that it is easily recognisable. (Eggs must not have anything stuck on them)
- 3. Eggs must be brought to school on Monday 29th March 2021
- Eggs will be rolled from the top of our special egg rolling tube. No pushing of any form will be 4. allowed.
- The egg that rolls the farthest in straight-line distance from the bottom of the ramp will be the 5. winner.
- 6. Each class holds their own egg roll competition with the 3 winners attending the final on the morning of Thursday 1st April at 11.00am.
- 7. Prizes will be given to the winner of each class race after the finale on Thursday 1st April. A prize will also be awarded by each class teacher for the most creatively decorated egg. Teachers will look particularly for those which are the **child's own work**.

Unfortunately, due to covid restrictions, we are unable to hold a live grand final that parents and families are able to attend in person this year. We will invite families of children in the grand final to join a live stream of the final so that they can still join in the fun. A link will be sent to parents and carers prior to the final.
