Plaistow and Kirdford Annual Easter Egg Roll for Years R to 6

We are so eggcited!

It's that time of year where we get out our paints, chase some chickens, boil some eggs and get ready for the eggstravagansa of the year: The Annual Easter Roll!

On Monday 27th March, children are invited to bring in a decorated hen's egg to take part in our Easter Competition. There will be a class prize for the best decorated egg and the egg that rolls the furthest in the egg roll. There is no set theme this year, children can be as creative as they like. During the week, everyone will take part in a class heat egg roll. The three eggs that roll the furthest will be selected to take part in the Grand Final on Friday 31st March.

The Grand Final will take place at 10.00am on Friday 31st March and all families are invited to attend and join in the fun. School will finish at 1.15pm on Friday 31st March.



The rules are simple:

- 1. The hen's egg must be hard-boiled.
- 2. The egg should be decorated by hand using paint or felt tips so that it is easily recognisable. (Eggs must not have anything stuck on them)
- 3. Eggs must be brought to school on Monday 27th March.
- 4. Eggs will be rolled from the top of our special egg rolling tube . No pushing of any form will be allowed.
- 5. The egg that rolls the farthest in straight-line distance from the bottom of the ramp will be the winner.
- 6. Each class holds their own egg roll competition with the 3 winners attending the final on the morning of **Friday 31st March**.
- 7. Prizes will be given to the winner of each class race after the finale on Friday 31st March. A prize will also be awarded by each class teacher for the most creatively decorated egg. Teachers will look particularly for those which are the child's own work.



We are very excited about the egg roll - there was much excitement in assembly when it was announced earlier this term! We look forward to seeing you on Friday 31st March for our Grand Final.
