On 23rd January at 6pm, we are inviting all parents to our special VIPERS evening.

VIPERS is our new approach to developing and extending reading comprehension and vocabulary throughout the school. Research shows that children who leave primary schools able to demonstrate a good knowledge and use of ambitious vocabulary are better placed to achieve strong outcomes at Key Stage Three.

The evening will begin at 6pm in the school hall with a brief introduction from Miss Clark and Mr King. Parents and carers will then have the opportunity to visit workshops in Key Stage One (Reception, Years One and Two), Lower Key Stage Two (Years Three and Four) and Upper Key Stage Two (Years Five and Six). At these workshops, you will see VIPERS in action in a one-to-one reading session. By the end of the workshop, parents will go away with a toolkit of questions and strategies they can use at home to get the most out of hearing their child read.

This will make reading at home more engaging for everyone involved, a more meaningful experience and will have an impact not only on their reading comprehension but on their writing as well.

Each workshop will run for twenty minutes. Parents will have the opportunity to attend two workshops. The second workshop will begin at 6.55pm.
